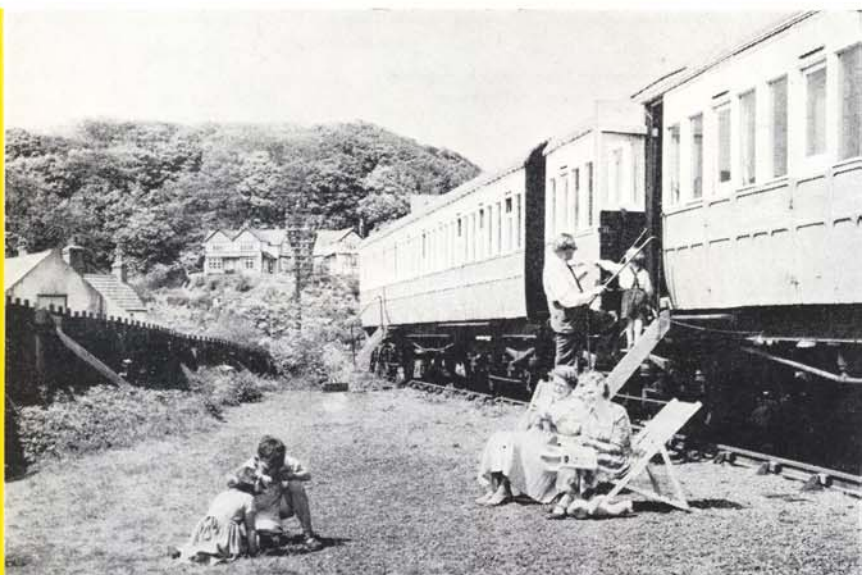

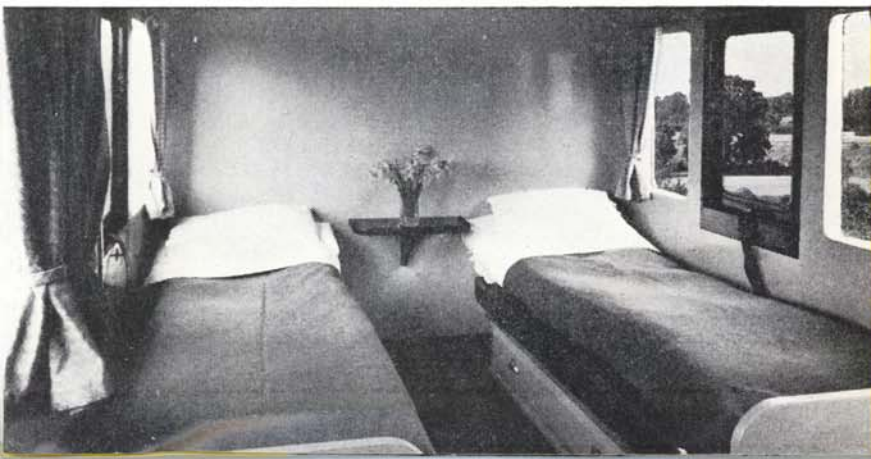
CONDITIONS OF HIRE

No member of the party or any person visiting the party at the coach shall have any right of action against the British Transport Commission or any other person owning, working or using any railway, or premises (whether jointly or otherwise), upon which the users of the Camping Coach are permitted to enter, in respect of (a) injury (fatal or otherwise), loss, damage or delay or (b) loss or damage or delay to property (unless occasioned by the proved negligence of the British Transport Commission or their servants) which, but for the exercise of the permission, would not have arisen.

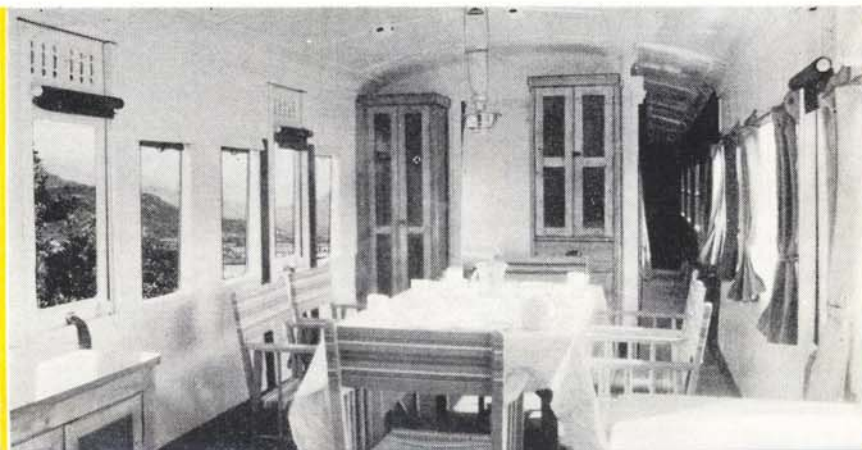

GENERAL INFORMATION

Camping Coaches provide sleeping accommodation for four, six or eight persons, a commodious living-room and a fully-equipped kitchen.

The eight-berth Western Region Camping Coaches consist of 2 two-berth and 1 four-berth cabins, the four-berth cabin being fitted with a movable bed which can, if desired, be transferred to one of the two-berth cabins.

All coaches are fully equipped with crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils, towels, table and bed linen.

Lighting, cooking and heating is by paraffin fuel, the cost of which is not included in the rental. Supplies are obtainable from the Station Master at a moderate charge.

At Robin Hood's Bay (7) and Scalby (8) in the North Eastern Region, lighting, cooking and heating is by electricity. Tenants pay for current used by prepayment meter.

The six-berth coaches at Bolton Abbey (9), Goathland (10), Ravenscar (13) Cloughton (11), Seascale (80), Silloth (81) and Lakeside (Windermere) (76) and two of the coaches at Rhuddlan (70) are provided with Calor Gas for lighting, heating and cooking. A weekly charge of 12s. 6d. is made for the gas.

The eight-berth Western Region Camping Coaches at Aberdovey (122), Barmouth Jct. (124), Borth (111), Dawlish Warren (119), Fairbourne (126), Penally (130), St. Agnes (117), Blue Anchor (132) and Marazion (116) are provided with Calor Gas. A weekly charge of 15s. 0d. for the gas being payable to the Station Master.

Coaches are cleaned at each change of tenancy and provided with fresh linen weekly.

Drinking water and toilet facilities are available on nearby station premises.

Camping Coaches are booked on the condition that tenants purchase in advance not less than three, four or six adult ordinary return rail tickets for a four, six or eight-berth coach as the case may be (two children counting as one adult) from their home station to the station serving the camping coach.

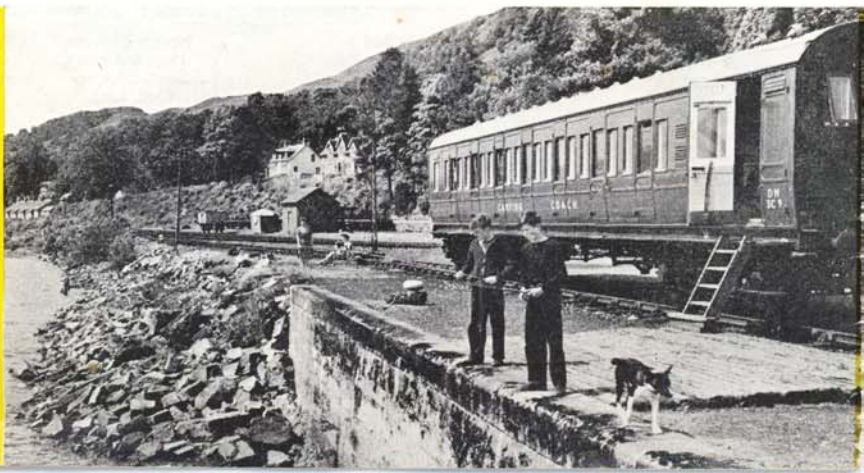
As the demand for Camping Coaches greatly exceeds the accommodation available during the holiday months, it is inevitable that a number of applicants must be disappointed. In allocating the available accommodation the management give preference to parties travelling the longest rail distance.

Camping coaches are available from the end of March to the end of October and may be hired for one or two weeks.

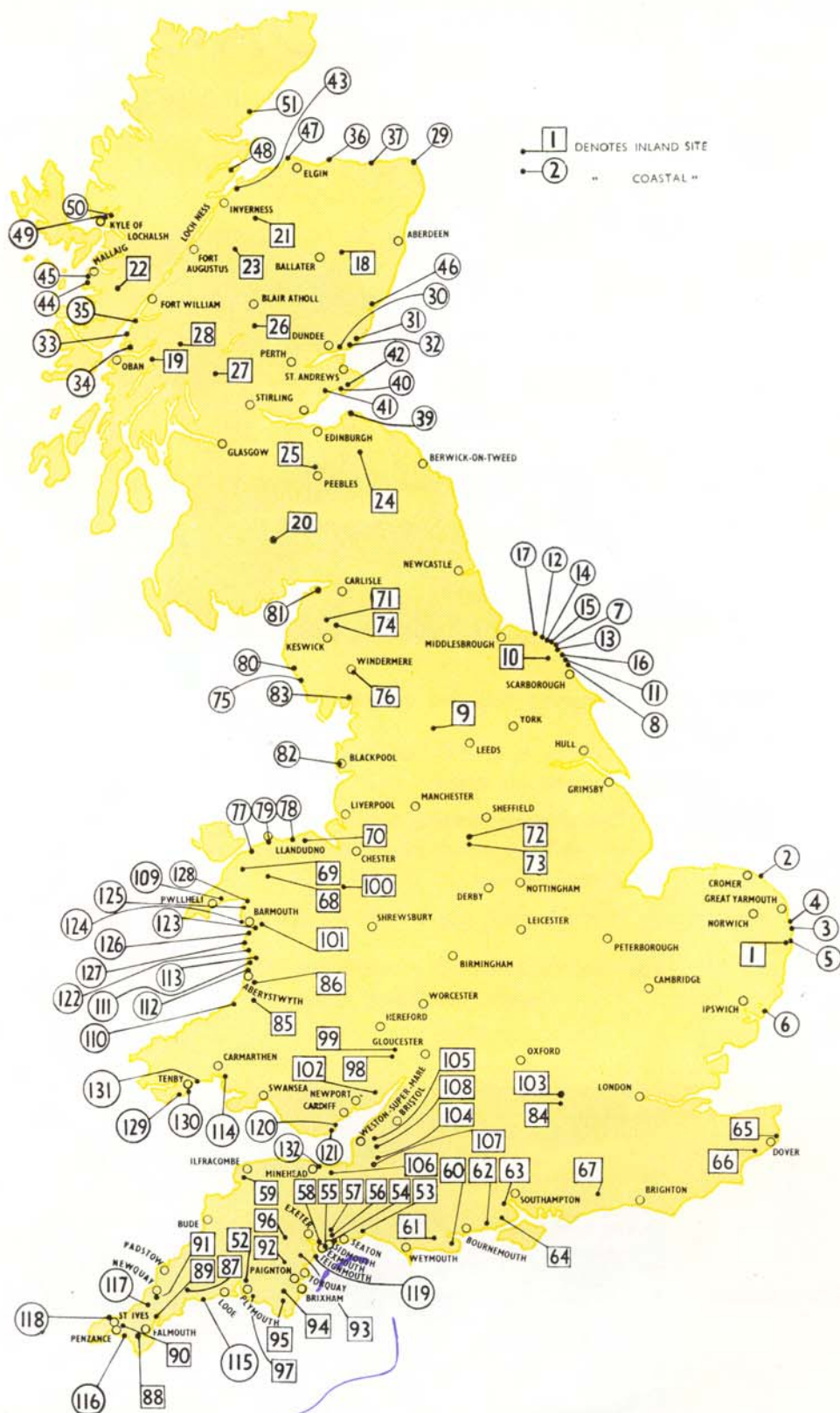
CAMPING COTTAGES (NORTH EASTERN REGION) AND CAMPING APARTMENTS (SCOTTISH REGION)
